



COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER

WHEREAS, on August 27, 2017, the County Judge issued a proclamation declaring a state of disaster for Orange County resulting from Hurricane Harvey;

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating declaration of a state of disaster continue to exist; and


WHEREAS, §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code Provides that a local state of disaster may not be continued for a period of excess of seven days without the consent of the governing body of the political subdivision;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONER'S COURT of Orange County;


1. That the state of disaster proclaimed for Hurricane Harvey by the County Judge on August 27, 2017 shall continue until terminated by order of the Commissioners Court.
2. This order is passed as an emergency measure and pursuant to Orange County Office of Emergency Management and shall become effective on the 4 day of September 2017.
