Currently the west end of Orange County is experiencing high levels of rainfall with some roadways being covered with water. Reports have indicated Hwy 105, Hwy 1131, several roads in Rose City and some roadways in the western parts of the city of Vidor are currently under water. Use caution when traveling any roadways and use alternate routes when and if possible.

The National Weather Service has advised rainfall will continue in the upcoming hours. We will continue to monitor this situation.

Water levels over the roadways can be deceiving in the dark and you should never attempt to drive across any water covered roadways.
