The Orange County Emergency Management continue to monitor projected rainfall amounts. Reports of high water over roadways in the Vidor area and in the western parts of the county have been received.

We urge citizens to stay off the roadways and to monitor local media outlets for weather updates and for business/school closures.

Do not drive on roadways that are covered with water. The depth is deceptive in the darkness. A car can stall in at least six inches of water and a foot of water can cause a vehicle to float or be swept off the roadway.
