Orange County Judge John Gothia has confirmed that Christus St. Elizabeth and Baptist hospitals are not accessible at this time due to flooding. Reports of flooded roadways are coming in from all parts of Orange County and Southeast Texas.

All Orange County governmental offices have been closed for the day and most Orange County schools have also cancelled classes for the day.

County Officials are strongly urging all citizens to remain indoors and only travel if absolutely necessary. Calls to 911 should only be made in life-threatening emergencies due to the hazards for first responders travelling flooded roadways.
