In reference to the above stated RFP-26001, the following additional information is provided for clarification and/or response to questions received.

- 1.) Will annual contract price increases based on Consumer Price Index (CPI) be allowed during the initial term?

Answer: **No**

- 2.) Are there any pre-identified DMS / Dumpsite locations? If so can you please provide the locations. -

Answer: **Yes, the county landfill... address: 11265 FM 1442 Orange, Texas 77630 GPS: 30°07'09.41"N 93°52'53.34"W**

- 3.) Will the payment for hazardous trees and limbs be for the cut only and placement of debris safely onto the ROW for collection?

Answer: **The payment for hazardous trees and limbs will include cut and hauling, not placing into the ROW for collection.**

- 4.) Will the payment for Hazardous Stumps include hauling?

Answer: **Yes**

- 5.) When will intent to award be made and how will it be communicated to proposers?

Answer: **Intent to award is before June 1, 2026.**

6.) Please confirm if the scope of work for white good removal includes the removal and disposal of any putrescent food from refrigerators or freezers.

Answer: **YES**

7.) Will equitable price adjustments be authorized either annually or at time of contract renewal?

Answer: **NO**

8.) Regarding the evaluation of the hourly pricing, how does the County intend on weighing the hourly line items?

Answer: **All proposals will be evaluated as a whole.**

9.) Can the County explain the exact methodology evaluators are required to use to determine which price proposal will receive the Maximum Points as it is not clearly specified in the RFP specifications?

Answer: **All proposals will be evaluated as a whole.**

10.) **Section S, Items 1 and 4** are currently priced as “Each.” Given that costs can vary significantly based on size, we request that these items be priced according to the Schedule of Fees (SF) -Answer: **Yes, it can be priced to schedule of fees versus as "each"**

11.) **Section S, Items 1 through 5:** Pricing for these services varies significantly depending on whether the materials are classified as RACM (Regulated Asbestos Containing Material) or Non-RACM. Due to these cost differences, we request this section be designated as Non-RACM only, with a separate section added for RACM demolition.

Answer: **Yes, this can be separated into separate sections between RACM and Non-RACM**
