- October class is still a work in progress. Working with TDEM to get class scheduled.

Planning/Programs - Stephen Tew

- Still would like U.P. to do a presentation. Need a good contact.
- Starting tomorrow (9/14/2023) FM 1006 and Hwy 87 intersection will be closed for 5 days, Hwy 87 will still flow.

Membership - Elgin Browning – No report

Public Health – Sandee White

- There are 143 new COVID cases, however showing a decline this week. Symptoms are flu-like.
- COVID 19 is no longer subsidized.

Industry Group - Jerry Ziller

- Sheltering during storms in the LEPC room has been prepared.
- Will be working with Regius Guillory for sign placement with new construction.

TDEM – Caci Groom

- The expiration date on COVID test has been extended to December.

- Hazardous Mitigation Grant for Winter Storm Uri DR #4705 still available for local governments, state agencies, and private non-profits regardless of whether you were affected by the storm. Caci Groom will send an email for Mary to forward to the group.

Old Business:

- Folders have been sent to all the schools.
- Evote was sent out on August 11th for request to purchase forty “Burn Ban” signs and eight “Burn Ban” banners for the County totaling \$1,740 (\$580 for signs and \$1,160 for banners). Votes-24 yes/0 no.

New Business:

- If any entity needs more “Burn Ban” signs, let Elgin Browning know. Burn ban enacted for 90 days beginning August 8, 2023.

Presentation: No presentation.

Announcements/Additional comments:

- Joel Ardoin spoke about the changes with the STAN system. The new company is Everbridge and it will be a slow transition. Blackboard will terminate at the end of September. Pat Grimes will be working to get everyone on board. Everbridge is easier to operate than Blackboard. The system will still be referred to as STAN.
- STAN was used during the evacuation of the Gist Fire. Only 50 of the evacuees were signed up for STAN. The majority evacuated were by door-to-door contact.
- Doug Cramer spoke about a recent event which used IPAWS. Joel Ardoin advised that we do not have IPAWS in our region.
- Doug Cramer with the National Weather Service stated there possibly be rain for the next few days.
- Joel Ardoin recognized the Red Cross for setting up a shelter at Pine Forest Baptist Church during the evacuation for the Gist Fire.

News/Recent Emergencies

Terry Road fire-burned approximately 15 acres. No houses lost. Many agencies assisted.

Little Cypress fire at Hwy 87 and Hwy 12.

Vidor Old Hwy 90 railroad tie fire near Jefferson Railport Terminal.

Gist Fire burned 417 acres. No houses lost. 75% contained. SCNA activated. Several agencies assisted.

Old Business:

- Burn ban signs distributed. There are four new Highway signs distributed within the county. Joel Ardoin explained these signs will be used as emergency signs and will be stored in a designated POD warehouses within each precinct.

New Business:

- Budget discussed. It is requested that Conference budget be increased from \$10,000 to \$15,000 since TDEM is no longer sponsoring fees and Advertising budget be increased from \$8,000 to \$10,000 due to Walraven's increase in prices. Budget changes will be sent to all members and voted/adopted at the January meeting.
- Burn ban update-Judge Gothia approved an additional 45 days on November 7, 2023.
- Walraven requesting to renewal contract for the folders sent to local elementary schools. The Early Bird Discount is \$288.40. Funds are budgeted and it is okay to proceed.

- Joel Ardoin reported that the Orange County Expo Center is in the process of getting an audio visual upgrade. The screen in the LEPC room is larger and there is a new projector. Audio is now available in the LEPC room as well. The EOC and Ballroom has also been upgraded.
- Brian Ousley with Orangefield ISD spoke about the \$42.9 M bond that pass and what improvements that will be made.
