NOAA/EPA's Computer Aided Management of Emergency Operations (CAMEO)

Free for Tier II Data Managers and Local Emergency Planners

Course Description: Understand the hazardous material threat in your jurisdiction. Experienced instructors will train you how to use the CAMEO[®] Suite software* to plan for hazardous material incidents. This introductory course will focus on CAMEO Data Manager (DM), CAMEO Chemicals, and MARPLOT.

Target Audience: Tier II data managers and local emergency planners in Texas.

We will focus on the following emergency planning skills using CAMEO[®] Suite software:

- How to obtain and import EPCRA Tier II data for your local jurisdiction
- Explore chemicals, their interactions, and create a customized facility planning document
- How to categorize and map Tier II facilities
- Import critical infrastructure mapping layers and create hazard zones around facilities
- Evaluate potentially affected populations and infrastructure in hazard zones
- How to export, maintain, and share information

Class Information: This course is open to Texas residents only. Eligibility and course pre-requisite information is located on the course registration form maintained by TDEM.

Each 5-week course includes:

- Online Classroom with 24/7 access to lessons, pre-recorded videos & activities
- 2-hour weekly, live Q&A webinars via Zoom from 10am-12pm CST
