- JULY Program - Energy Transfer currently operates a natural gas pipeline (Trunkline Gas) in Orange Co.
 - converting one 30-inch to transport light sweet crude oil (450-570,000) barrels per day.
 - from the North Dakota Bakken and Three Forks production areas to reach the Patoka hub near Patoka, Illinois and continue to refineries in the Gulf Coast area.
 - request an opportunity to attend one of LECP meetings to discuss the project, the type of products that will be transported through and emergency preparedness. The pipeline is scheduled to go into service later this year.
