- **New Business:**

- Energy Transfer currently operates a natural gas pipeline (Trunkline Gas) in Orange CO..
 - converting one 30-inch to transport light sweet crude oil (450-570,000) barrels per day .
 - from the North Dakota Bakken and Three Forks production areas to reach the Patoka hub near Patoka, Illinois and continue to refineries in the Gulf Coast area.
 - request an opportunity to attend one of LEPC meetings to discuss the project, the type of products that will be transported through and emergency preparedness. The pipeline is scheduled to go into service later this year.
- FEMA release of National Planning System Description (Jeremy)
- EPA proposes revisions to Risk Management Program (RMP) to improve chemical process safety and further protect communities and first responders. Improve the ability of LEPCs and local emergency response officials to better prepare for emergencies.

- EPA Region 6 Logistics Coordinators and the Natural Disaster Operations Workgroup in Texas need Post Hurricane sites for Field Operation Camps, and Hazardous Waste Staging in each coastal county in preparation for Hurricane Season.
