- DOT Announces over \$20 Million in Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness Grants (Thomas)  
For this grant cycle, HMEP applicants were encouraged to allocate funding towards:
  1. developing or revising emergency plans and training activities to account for bulk transportation of energy product by rail and over the road;
  2. conducting commodity flow studies to determine the frequency and quantity of hazardous materials shipments being transported through local communities; and
  3. training emergency responders to respond appropriately to incidents involving hazardous materials.
