HEARING PURPOSE:

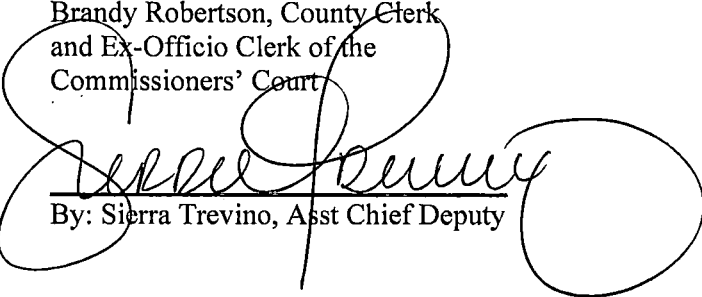
- (1) improve a portion of Seven Pines Street within the subdivision of the Minor Plat of Seven Pines, in Precinct 2, to comply with County standards and
